20 Order,



26 Inc. Long Term Disability Plan. Defendants Canada Life
27 Assurance Company, Adept Technology, Inc. Long Term
28 Disability Plan and Adept Technology, Inc. Life Insurance

1 Plan violated the provisions of the Adept Technology, Inc.
2 Long Term Disability Plan by failing to pay Plaintiff the
3 benefits to which Plaintiff was entitled under the Adept
4 Technology, Inc. Long Term Disability Plan by reason of that
5 disability.
